COVID-19 SAFETY RULES and SPECIFIC TRIAL INFORMATION:

- **The Trial Order and Run Order have been altered to limit the number of people at the facility. Please refer to the Run Order on Page One of this Premium. Where possible, please plan to be at the trial site for the minimum amount of time.**
- **We will offer Day-of-Trial entries (assuming there are runs available) at 7:30 am and at 12:00 noon, to accommodate the altered run order.**
- **If runs are available on the day of the trial, entry forms will be available at the trial site, at a separate table from the Trial Secretary station. Please be prepared to use social distancing procedures while filling out forms, keep masks on, and use hand sanitizer when needed.**
- **There will be NO crating in the building for rally participants. There is ample parking near the building entrance, so crating out of vehicles is convenient.**
- **Use social distancing procedures while inside the trial building, keeping yourself and your dogs 6 feet from other participants and workers at all times.**
- **Wear a mask at all times while in the trial building. The one exception is that you may remove your mask during your rally run, once you have entered the ring and the judge has given you the OK to do so.**
- **Masks will be worn by all participants while doing walk-throughs. We will limit the number of people entering the ring for walk-throughs at any one time in order to comply with social distancing rules.**
- **No spectators who are not entered in the trial or working at the trial will be allowed in the building.**
- **Do not attend the event if you have any illness symptoms, or if you believe you've been exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid-19. We reserve the right to excuse anyone who is showing signs of illness.**
- **SCASC and its representatives reserve the right to request that anyone not following these safety rules and procedures leave the facility immediately. No refunds will be available to anyone being asked to leave.**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- PLEASE NOTE that these trials have limited entries. Once the limits are reached, we will put all additional entries on a Waiting List, and notify exhibitors of their status.
- No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from any or all ASCA programs, or a person not in good standing with ASCA.
- All entries must be submitted on the latest approved ASCA entry form, for the event in which your dog is entered. Entry forms are available on the ASCA website, at www.asca.org/home/business-office/rules-forms.

- Pre-entries will be refunded only upon written request received prior to close of pre-entries. No other refunds will be granted.
- Any check returned to our bank will invalidate all entries associated with that check. Writer of the check will be required to pay a \$50 administrative fee, in addition to all bank charges associated with the returned check. If the issue is not resolved within 10 days, the writer of said check will be reported to ASCA.
- No bitches in season will be allowed to participate in any class in this trial.
- Dogs must be a minimum of 6 months of age to compete in any class in this trial. The age of all dogs will be calculated as of April 11, 2021.
- No classes will be judged prior to the posted start times on the schedule, but may be judged later.
- Rally courses will be performed in the Terroux Training facility, a fully-conditioned indoor facility, with carpeted flooring. Building will be open to exhibitors at 7:30 am. Crating will NOT be allowed in the building; crating out of your vehicle is recommended.
